INTELLIGENCE CORPS GOLF ASSOCIATION SPRING MEET 2012 UPAVON GOLF CLUB WILTSHIRE 15 MAR 2012

Introduction

1. The 2012 Intelligence Corps Golf Association Spring Meet will be played at Upavon Golf Club on 15 Mar 2012. Upavon is high quality inland links course situated approximately 15 miles North of Salisbury. Directions can be found at www.upavongolfclub.co.uk.

Competition

2. There will be a lesson with the 'Pro' in the morning at 10.00 am, followed by the main competition which will be played over 18 holes in stableford format. There are a number of prizes:

- a. Best stableford score.
- b. Runner up stableford score.
- c. Best gross score (please finish on all holes).
- d. The usual prizes for nearest the pin, longest drive and other prizes TBD on the day.

3. Players intending to make use of the lesson with the pro are requested to arrive at Upavon Golf Club no later than 0815 hrs. Those players only taking part in the 18-hole stableford competition are requested to arrive no later than 0945 hrs. The event is open to everybody with a connection to the Intelligence Corps and guests are most welcome. Timings

4. The program is:

- 0800 hrs Players meet for bacon rolls and coffee at Upavon Golf club.
- 0830 hrs Practice with the pro.
- 1000 hrs First Tee off for 18 hole competition.
- 1430 hrs (ish) Late lunch / Prize giving.
- 1500 hrs (ish) Depart

Etiquette

5. Players are requested to acknowledge club members and their rights throughout the day. Upavon Golf Club has some challenging holes and players are asked to watch ball flight closely to assist with finding errant balls and to help speed up play. As normal, care must be taken to rake all bunkers and repair divots and pitch marks.

Administrative details

6. Cost. Green fees for the day will be £12 and monies will be collected on the day. There is no need to forward any monies to me prior to the event. This includes all green fees, practice with the pro, and a contribution towards prizes. All food and drinks are at the individual's expense.
7. Club Dress Code. Upavon's dress code is smart/casual at all times during the day, but no jeans, trainers, collarless shirts, outdoor/waterproof clothes or shoes worn on the golf course are to be worn in the public rooms.
9. Accommodation. Military accommodation is available throughout the Salisbury Plain area, although bids should be made ASAP to avoid disappointment. All accommodation arrangements are an individual responsibility. Reasonable bed and breakfast accommodation is also available locally. Details can be sought from local tourist information offices or the internet.
10. Travel at Public Expense. Travel for this Corps event is authorised for serving members at public expense attributed to AG's TLB. For costs claimed via unit imprest accounts, RAOs must use their own unit UIN but quote Local Project Code (LPC) ZZP 1E1 1403 and Resource Account Code PDA002. For contract travel bookings movement staff must use the appropriate UIN with Purpose of Travel Code (POT Code) 16, charged Resource Account Code PDA002. Every effort must be made to minimise public travel costs by sharing vehicles. A copy of this instruction should accompany travel applications or claims.
11. On Duty Status. Competitors should advise their RAO to ensure that their participation in the event has been published on respective Unit Part 1 Orders, to formalise their 'on duty' status for this event.
