ARMY GOLF ASSOCIATION EASTERN REGION SPRING MEETING – 18 APR 19

- A. Royal and Ancient Golf Governing Body – Official website www.randa.org
1. **Date and venue.** This meeting will be held at Belton Park, www.beltonpark.co.uk on Thu 18 Apr 19. First tee-off time is scheduled for 1000hrs, coffee and bacon rolls will be served from 0900hrs and there will be a competition brief prior to 0930hrs. Practice facilities are available prior to the meet starting.
 2. **Eligibility.** Only members and associate members of the AGA are eligible to compete. Membership of the AGA costs £15.00 per annum; membership forms are available from the Secretary AGA Eastern Region or available on the day at the meeting.
 3. **Competitions.** This is the first event in the ERG calendar, and starts the Eclectic Order of Merit (OOM) for the selection of the team to represent the Region at Worksop 25-26 Sep 18. The following competitions will be played for within the 18 holes, a comprehensive brief will be given on the morning for the format of each competition:
 - a. 18 Hole Individual Stableford Comp (Div 1 & 2 split will be an exact split dependant on players).
 4. **Format.** The format for the day will be as follows:
 - a. 0830 - 0900 arrive at Belton Park Golf Course, bacon roll with tea or coffee.
 - b. 0930 Competition brief.
 - c. 1002 First tee time.
 - d. 1400 Rolling lunch as the rounds finish.
 - e. Prize Giving after last group finished.
 5. **Prizes.** Prizes will be awarded for each division. As highlighted by the masses, the prizes will consist of and various golfing accessories for eligible AGA members.
 6. **Rules.** Current R&A Golf which can be found at Ref A will apply throughout along with Belton Park Golf Course local rules which are listed on the reverse of the score card.
 7. **Starting times.** Will be distributed during the week commencing Mon 15 Apr 19. If individuals fail to turn up, the flights will stand unless it results in a single player.

9. **Cost.** The cost for the day is £35 per individual which includes coffee etc on arrival, 18 holes of golf and a light lunch. 2's will not be included on this occasion. You are encouraged to seek financial assistance from your Unit ECOPF and PRI.

10. **Entry.** All details for entry are listed below:

a. Entry is a simple **email to be submitted by COP Fri 12 Apr 19;**

- 1) Name

- 3) HCap
- 4) Contact mobile

b. Only a maximum of 50 entrants are allowed. Entries will be taken on a first come first serve basis.

c. Cash is the method of payment on the day before first tee off.

d. Please do not send any money via post.

e. All monies are to be settled prior to tee off.

f. Cancellations can be made up to 18 Apr 18, if you fail to show on the day you will be required to pay the deposit.

11. **Future AGA Eastern Region Meetings.**

- **Autumn – 15 Aug 19 – 27 Holes – Burghley Park GC**

12. **Travel at Public Expense.** The use of the Representational Sport Travel Vote is authorised in accordance with 2014DIN10-030. Every effort must be made to minimise publically funded travel costs by sharing vehicles.

13. **On Duty Status.** Golf Officers should advise their serving team members, both Regular and Reserve to ensure that their participation in the event has been published on respective Unit Part 1 Orders, to formalise their 'on duty' status for this event

14. **Summary.** The courses selected this year look to hold a great challenge for all. I encourage your support and ask that you pass this to all known golfers in your units.
