

d. **Scoring.** In the Main and Plate competition, one point will be awarded for a win, half a point for a halved match and zero for a loss. In the event of a tie between two teams, the team winning scores for the matches will be added together to determine the result. For example – if Team A wins one match 5/4 and Team B win one match 2/1 with the other drawn then Team A will go through with 5 points against 2. If however, the result is still level, then **one player from each team, nominated by the Team Captain**, will play sudden death over holes prescribed by the Championship Committee.

6. **Accommodation.** Accommodation is an individual unit responsibility.

7. **Travel at Public Expense.** Travel is authorised in accordance with **2019DIN10-025**. Every effort must be made to minimise publically funded travel costs by sharing vehicles.

8. **Final Instructions.** Detailed instructions for the Finals will be issued to all Teams on Wed 9 Jun 21.

9. **On Duty Status.** Team Captains should advise their RAO to ensure that their participation in the event has been published on respective Unit Part 1 Orders, to formalise their 'on duty' status for this event.
