1. The AGA Scotland Autumn meeting will take place at Dumbarnie links, Upper Largo, Fife KY8 6JQ on Wednesday 27 Oct 2021. Play will be one round of golf with the first tee off commencing at 0940.
2. Format – The format will be stableford using full handicap in 3 divisions off the blue tees.  
Div 1 H/Cap 0 – 9, Div 2 H/Cap 10 -18, Div 3 H/Cap 19 -28
3. Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in each division and a nearest the pin and longest drive will be in play, these holes will be picked on the day on the advice of the starter.
4. Cost for the day is £63 for the green fees, bacon rolls and coffee on arrival, range balls for the practice facility and prizes.
5. Dress - Normal golfing attire on the golf course. If you have an AGA Scotland shirt then please wear this to advertise the Society in the club house
6. Maximum attendance on the day is limited to 88 players and all those receiving this email have been successful in getting a start time. There is no requirement to send in a return as we normally do but can all players send me their official handicap by email and to inform me that they have paid. Please pay by BACS direct to the AGA RBS account using Name/Dumbarnie as the reference to account number 00130160, sort code 83-18-47.
7. To comply with Covid social distancing measures as they stand at today's date please be at the course 60 minutes before your tee time to get breakfast and then be at the first tee 10 minutes before your start time. Please stay in your 4 man bubble in the clubhouse and the only people on the putting green should be the next group to tee off.
8. At the end of the round all players are to make their way back to the clubhouse and hand in their score cards to the committee and then depart the course.
9. Dumbarnie links is an outstanding golf course, one of the very best in Scotland and we have secured a great deal with the course so please make the effort to attend on the day and get your handicap details to me as early as you can.
