At a wet and miserable Enville Golf Club the Army had mixed fortunes it has to be said, both teams winning and losing games, although neither was able to win sufficient games to be able to retain or regain the Inter Services Trophies. As a result, the RN won both the ladies and men's trophies for the first time since records began. I suspect the competition in Sep will be a closerun thing with added determination to succeed.	
		<ul> <li>d. The Development Inter Services took place at Thonock Park, home of Ping, in May, for the first time and was played in the same format as the main Inter Services.</li> </ul>	

	The Army fielded a strong team and batted hard reaping the rewards with a convincing victory. It is likely the success of this year will be mapped going forward in an effort to generate further sponsorships and great attendance from Serving Seniors across all three Services.  Season 2023 so far:	
	a. Strokeplay Championship – The Strokeplay, played at Belton Park for the first time proved a success, and congratulations to Spr Graeme Torrie (3 under gross) – the 2023 winner. For 2024 we will return to Belton Park albeit later in the year as the Matchplay and Strokeplay will swap months owing to a major event preventing our usual spot at Saunton in Jul. 	b. The Inter Unit Championship was held at Catterick GC, numbers were down slightly this year so please generate interest on your return to units. Whilst I would not expect to see you there, you might like to encourage others at unit level to attend. Next year we have yet to confirm the venue but will again publish this on the website once it is known.
