- 2. **Availability.** Commanding Officers (or Line Managers) are kindly requested to release their players to represent the Army in this fixture. If any player becomes unavailable, they are to inform the Army Golf Captain or Team Manager at the earliest opportunity.
- 3. **Reporting.** Players are to report to the Match Captain on Friday 05 Apr 24 (timing TBC) at Burnham & Berrow GC, St. Christophers Way, Burnham-on-Sea, TA8 2PE.
- 4. **Format.** As follows:
 - a. **05 Apr 24.** Arrival, practice round (tee times TBC). All to attend the competition draw (1900hrs).
 - b. **06-07 Apr 24.** Main event. Scratch team foursomes matchplay knockout and competition dinner on Saturday evening (jacket and AGA tie).
- 5. **Accommodation.** The Army Golf Association has booked all players in the Burham and Berrow GC Dormy House. The Match Captain is to liaise with the staff at Burham and Berrow GC on Fri 05 Apr 24 to coordinate the check-in/out of the team.

- 6. **Equipment and Dress.** Players are to wear PING red Army shirts/mid layers as issued and black trousers. Individuals without an Army Golf Clothing are to inform the Team Manager ASAP. Jacket and Tie **is required** for this fixture.
- 7. **Travel Authority.** The use of the Representational Sport Travel Vote is authorised for this fixture in accordance with <u>2019DIN10-025</u>. Applicants are to use their own UIN and Purpose of Travel (POT) Code 16 and also quote their own or the bidders unit UIN on the FMT 1000 when applying for white fleet vehicles. **Players should make every effort to minimise costs by vehicle sharing.**
- 8. **Drivers Hours.** It is each players responsibility to comply with Drivers' Hours Scheme A, details of which can be found in <u>DSA 03. Movement and Transport Safety Regulations.</u> The daily duty time on 07 Apr 24 may exceed 9 hours prior to dispersal. Plans for return travel should be considered accordingly.
