## JOINING INSTRUCTIONS – GOLF SKILLS (ADVANCED) COURSE (22 MAR 27)

Reference:

A. **2024DIN10-039**

### Background

1. **Course.** In accordance with Reference A, the Golf Skills (Advanced) Course will be held at Brampton Heath Golf Centre (BHGC), Church Brampton, Northamptonshire, during the period 22 - 26 Mar 27; the service provider for this training will be 'ProJAm'.
2. **Aim.** ProJAm aims to teach and coach Golf to Service Personnel. The Advanced Course gives experienced players an insight into the routines of the elite player both on and off the course. Included within this course is extensive short game development and on course tuition.

### General

3. **Availability.** You are to ensure that this letter is brought to the attention of your Commanding Officer (CO) or Line Manager for approval.
4. **Cancellations.** Individuals are requested to notify ProJAm of any non-availability at the earliest opportunity by telephone (01865 522360); this notification must be supported by an e-mail ([fiona@projam.biz](mailto:fiona@projam.biz)). Cancellations within 3 weeks of the start date may have any payments withheld in lieu of a new course date.
5. **Reporting.** All students are to report to BHGC at 0845 hrs on **Mon 22 Mar 27**; any student who is arriving late must inform BHGC (and ProJAm) at the earliest opportunity.
6. **Discipline.** Students with any ongoing issues that may impact their ability to attend or complete the course once registered, should consider booking a course they can guarantee completing. Also, should any student [whilst on course] become involved in incidents warranting subsequent disciplinary action (including those which occur outside of normal working hours), they will be Returned to the Unit (RTU).

### Accommodation / Messing.

7. Transit accommodation will be booked by ProJAm if requested on the online bid form, as no Officer or SNCO accommodation is available at Gamecock Barracks for course attendees. It

is the sole responsibility of the **individual** to confirm/cancel this accommodation directly with ProJAm **NLT 2 weeks prior to the course start** (i.e. by **COP Fri 5 Mar 27**); contact details are [fiona@projam.biz](mailto:fiona@projam.biz) or Fiona on 01865 522360.

8. **Location.** Accommodation will be at Gamecock Barracks, Bramcote, Nuneaton, Warwickshire CV11 6QN. Students are to note that the accommodation is of a transit nature and is **ungraded**; there is no military transport between Gamecock Barracks and the golf course. Receipt of a non-availability does not mean that privately acquired accommodation can be charged to the MOD; it is to be borne by the individual.

9. **Accommodation Reporting.** Students who book accommodation at Gamecock Barracks are to report to the Guardroom, between the evening of **Sun 21 Mar 27 and completion of the first day's training** to collect accommodation keys. All rooms are single occupancy (subject to availability). All keys are to be **returned to the Guardroom** on departure. A bill will be raised against the individual if a key is lost. The barracks do NOT provide bedding; all students must provide their own sleeping system. Concerns regarding accommodation may be raised with RQMS(A) or SQMS(A) 30 Signal Regiment on 01455 222514 or in the QM(A) Department – if possible while on course so any issues can be remedied.

10. **Messing.** The unit also operates a 'pay-as-you-dine' system; therefore, all students must ensure sufficient funds to pay for their meals. If applicable, all meals will be taken in the 'All Ranks' Hub Dining facility, **where meal timings are:**

- a. Breakfast - 0700-0800 hrs.
- b. Lunch - 1230-1315 hrs.
- c. Evening meal - 1630-1800 hrs.

Please note that due to the course timings and driving distance involved, you will not be able to take lunch at the barracks, and it is unlikely that you will arrive back in time for the evening meal. However, you may wish to check this.

11. **Packed Meals.** Be aware that Gamecock Barracks cannot provide packed meals. If students wish to take their own food to the course, it must be consumed away from the clubhouse as this is a commercial entity.

12. **Golf Course Refreshments.** Messing arrangements exist at the golf club where some discounts may apply, however all costs must be borne by the individual. ProJAm will circulate further details.

### **Course Fees**

13. **General.** Professionals, Juniors and Amateurs (ProJAm) are contracted to provide facilities and tuition for all golf courses advertised by the ASCB. For your information, a letter of introduction from ProJAm is shown at Enclosure 1.

14. **Payments.** To secure your place on a course, a deposit of £110.00 is required by ProJAm **NLT 3 weeks before the course starts (i.e. by COP Fri 26 Feb 27), with the balance of the costs paid NLT one week before the course begins (i.e. by Fri 12 Mar 27).**

**Please Note: Usually there are only 10 places per course. Places are confirmed strictly by the deposit payment, no matter when you have sent the bid form. The sooner you pay the deposit, the sooner you are confirmed on the course. If you wait until 3 weeks before, you may not secure a place.**

You can choose to pay the deposit separately or the whole amount at once. If you only pay the deposit, ProJAm will remind you to pay the balance in due course. Payment is by bank transfer to the following account:

### **Administration**

15. **Documentation.** Students are to be in possession of the following documentation:
  - a. MOD Form 90 (Service identity card).
  - b. Unit telephone number (to facilitate emergency contact should the need arise).
16. **Clothing and Equipment.** The following are required for the duration of the course:
  - a. A minimum half-set of golf clubs with (including at least 1x wood and 1x putter), trolley is optional; please see 18 below.
  - b. Suitable civilian attire, including collared shirt, trousers, and jersey (jeans and t-shirt are not permitted).
  - c. Golf shoes (trainers and walking shoes/boots are unacceptable).
  - d. Waterproofs (civilian) and umbrella.
17. **Club Hire.** Students who do not own golf clubs may hire a half-set of golf clubs at a charge of £20.00 for the duration of the course. You must notify ProJAm of this by way of the online bid form.
18. **Golf Course Location.** A map is shown at Enclosure 3.
19. **Private Transport.** Students arriving at Gamecock Barracks in private vehicles should register the details with the Guardroom on arrival. A temporary vehicle pass will be issued and should be displayed at all times when within Gamecock Barracks. All vehicles are to be parked on the rear of the main square only, failure to do so will result in the car pass being withdrawn.
20. **Transport to Golf Course.** Students accommodated at Gamecock Barracks must be aware that transport to and from the course is an individual responsibility, and students should, where practicable, share vehicles.
21. **Medical.** All students should be fit to attend this course. All students must complete a registration form before the course, confirming they are responsible for their medical health and fit to participate in the course.

### **Miscellaneous**

22. **Pets.** Under no circumstances are pets to be brought to the course.

## GAMECOCK BARRACKS LOCATION

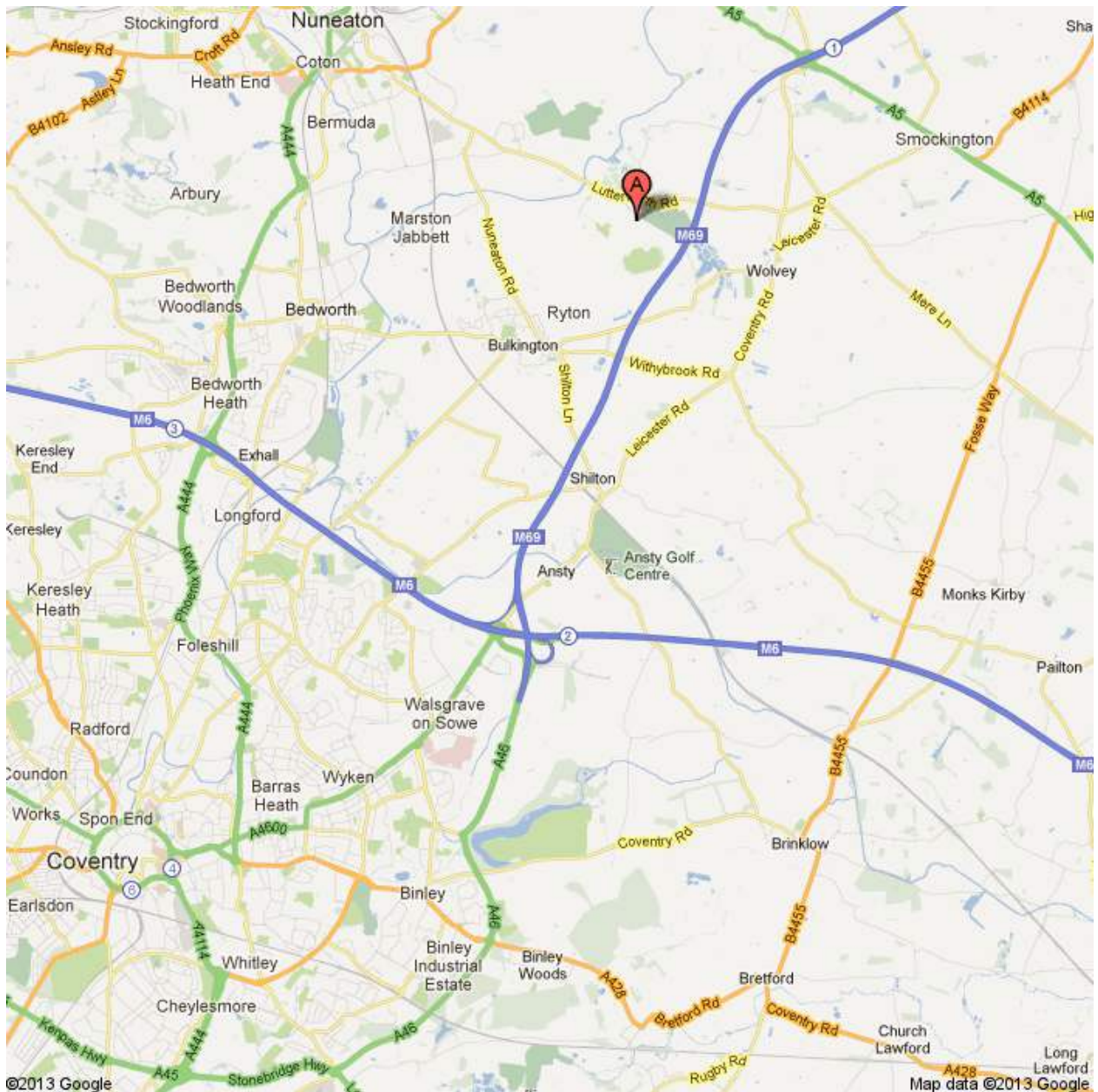
Camp Postcode is CV11 6QN.

After about 2 miles at a prominent crossroads turn left onto the Lutterworth Road (B4114) sign posted Nuneaton.

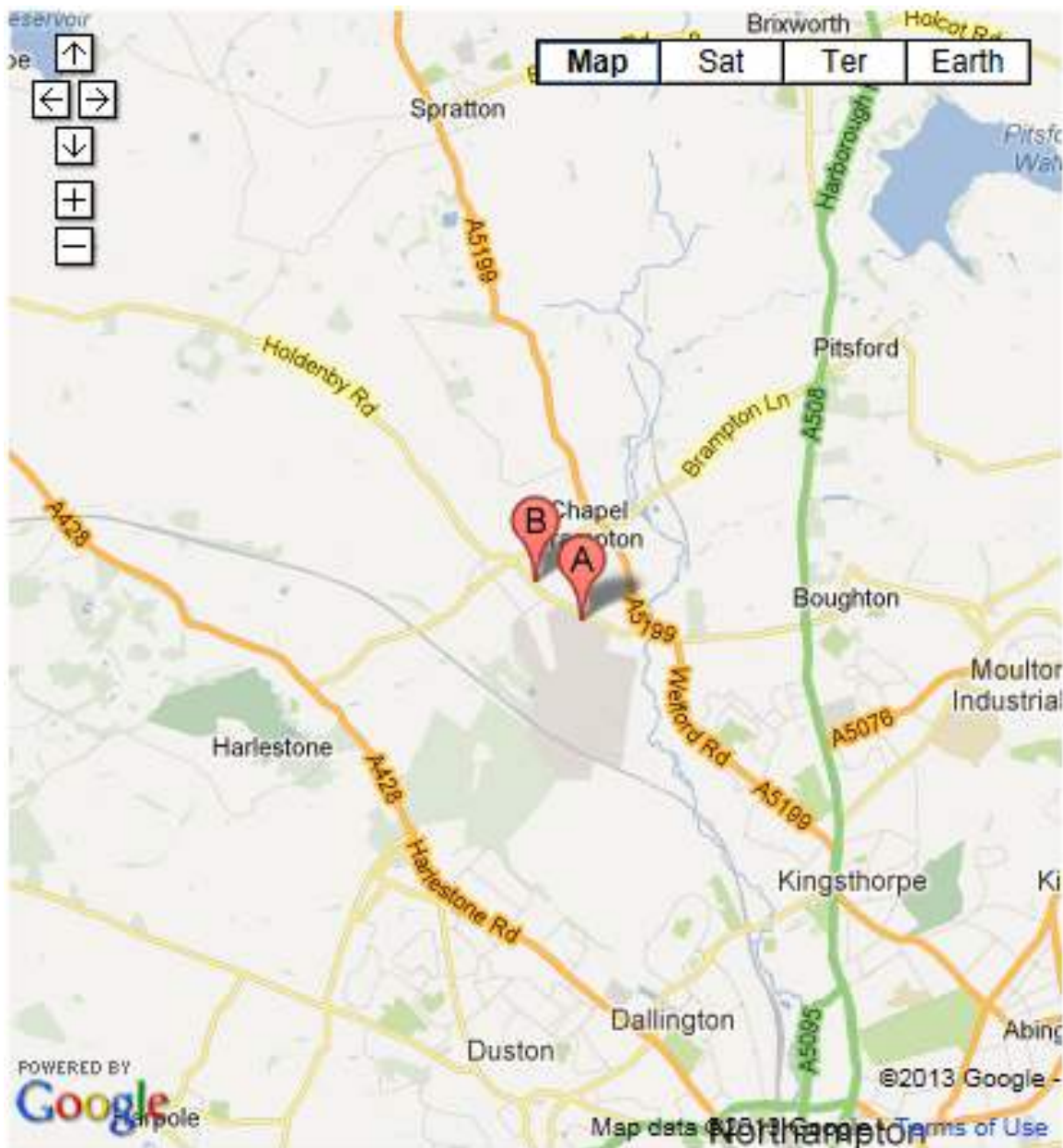
Gamecock Barracks is signposted from the B4114
