1. **Date:** Wed 27 Mar 24 **AM tee-off:** 0900 hrs

2. **Venue:** <u>Kirtlington Golf Club</u> **Address:** Kirtlington,

Kidlington OX5 3JY

- 3. **Event**. The 2024 RGA High Handicap Championships will take place at <u>Kirtlington Golf Club</u>. We are anticipating there will be high demand for this event and places will be limited to 56. Entry is still open so please share this AI, places will be allocated with a priority on handicaps above 18 however lower handicaps will be required to play and assist teams. Entry submission is through the following <u>link</u> and is active now.
- 4. **CO/Line Manager Authority**. Prior to completing your entry into this event, you are to ensure that this AI is brought to the attention of your Commanding Officer (CO) or Line Manager for approval. Should your availability for this event change, please contact the undersigned at the earliest opportunity.
- 5. **Eligibility.** The event is open to all serving, reserve and retired members of the Corps, who already play or would like to get into golf. The RGA actively encourages participation from golfers of all levels, it is always great to see new players come in and join us for as many enjoyable days out of the office as possible. Please continue to spread the word and encourage new players to come along and experience what the RGA is all about.
- 6. **Mandatory training.** ITR Heat Illness Prevention Modules. All personnel participating in this sport activity must complete the following modules prior to participating or delivering sporting activities at any level.
  - a. Module 1 All personnel involved in sport activity must complete Module 1 This effectively means every soldier who participates in sport. This will help all personnel understand the causes and effects of heat illness.

- b. The Chain of Command are requested to ensure that individuals have completed the required modules before they authorise their participation.
- 7. **Cost.** The cost for this event includes green fees, food and prizes.
- 8. A breakdown of the costs is as follows:

a.	Retired Members	£53
b.	SNCOs, Officers (Capt and above)	£48
C.	Lt's, Cpls and below	£43

- 9. If you fill in the return and cannot play for any reason, ensure you inform WO2 Baron by email before **COP Tue 19 Mar 24**. Failure to do this may result in you being charged the fee anyway as we are still required to pay the club.
- 10. **Payments**. The preferred option is for personnel to pay for events by transferring the required funds to the RGA account (BACS). Please ensure you have paid electronically by **COP Tue 19 Mar 24.**

- 11. **Format & Prizes.** The High Handicaps Championship will be played over 18 holes in the afternoon. There will be a 9-hole team Texas Scramble before the main competition. The format of the day is:
  - a. 9 Hole Texas Scramble (AM) Team 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - b. 18 Hole Stableford (PM) >18 handicap 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th
  - c. 18 Hole Stableford (PM) <18 handicap 1st & 2nd
- 12. **Scoring**. The lowest handicap in each group will be required to assist in marking the scores. Example cards will be on display when registering and the RGA Committee will assist with any questions. On completion of the round, after confirming the scores with all players, this scorecard is to be handed to SSgt Joey Burton. **Failure to do so could result in disqualification**.
- 13. **Timings.** As ever, it is expected that the timings for the event will be tight (**4-balls**) so pace of play is essential. If you cannot score then please encourage players to pick up and keep up with the group in front, as per golfing etiquette. Timings below are a guide; they will be confirmed on the Tee Sheet.

a.	0800 – 1000	Registration
b.	0900	First flight tee off AM round – Blenheim Course
C.	1130	Rolling Lunch
d.	1230	First flight tees off PM Round – Kidlington Course
e.	1830	Presentation

14. **Food.** Bacon rolls and coffee are provided on arrival. A rolling lunch will be available from 1130 in the main clubhouse. All drinks will be at your own expense.

- 15. **Dress.** All competitors are to ensure they wear appropriate golf attire. Jeans, trainers and spikes are not to be worn within the clubhouse.
- 16. **Travel.** In accordance with <u>2019DIN10-025</u>, travel is admissible at public expense using this Admin Instruction as authority within your respective Unit budget holder's agreement. All participants are to follow the current D&G on vehicle sharing.
- 17. **Accommodation.** If accommodation is required, it is the individual's responsibility to book.
- 18. **Approval.** The AI has been submitted and approved through the ASCB.
- 19. **Additional information.** The tee sheet will be published on **Fri 22 Mar 24** which will contain your group and all times for the day. To maximise the break and lunch availability, your group will remain the same for both rounds. If you wish to take part in this event, please fill out the form at this link **NLT Fri 15 Mar 24.**
- 20. If you are not a member of a golf club, you can now get iGolf which tracks your progress and gives you an official WHS handicap and personal liability insurance. The cost is £44 and the link can be found <a href="here">here</a>. This is encouraged for all non-members of golf clubs.
