1. **General.** The R SIGNALS will play against the Infantry at Belton Park Golf Club, Londonthorpe Road, Grantham, Lincs, NG31 9SH on 3 Apr 24. This is an AGA Division 1 League fixture. Team players are named in table 1 below, with reserve players in table 2. **SSgt Milan Rai** is the nominated Captain for the day.

2. **Selected Team.** Selected players in table 1, are required confirm availability for this fixture by making the match fee payment NLT 7 days prior to the fixture, if you are no longer available to attend this fixture, please contact the Match Captain or Corps Secretary to enable a reserve to be called forward. Reserve players are not required to pay the match fee unless called forward. Team selection is based on proximity to the fixture to enable all Royal Signals golfers the opportunity to represent the Corps.

2. **Format.** The format for the day is as follows:
  - a. **4 Ball Better Ball.** The AM round will be a friendly 4BBB handicap (90%) match.
  - b. **Individual.** The PM round will be eight individual handicap (100%) matches contributing to the AGA League.
3. **Timings.** The outline for the day is as follows:
  - a. 0730-0800hrs – Arrival of both teams; bacon sandwiches and coffee/tea is available. The team captains will discuss pairings/order of play.
  - b. 0830hrs – First morning tee.
  - c. 1230-1315hrs – Lunch
  - d. 1330hrs – First afternoon tee.
4. **Refreshments.** The cost for the day includes bacon roll/tea/coffee on arrival and lunch in between rounds. Any other refreshments will be at a personal cost.
5. **Cost.** The cost is offset by the Royal Signals Golf fund, a price of £30.00 per person is required to be paid by all those players selected, NLT 7days prior to the event by all players selected to play. Reserve players are not required to make any form of payment unless they are called forward.
  - a. Electronic payment is the preferred method of payment (Holts Bank Sort Code 16-19-26 Account number 19862585 use the reference R021 and add your surname e.g. R021JONES, cash must not be sent. If you are unable to pay using electronic payment, please contact the Royal Signals Golf Secretary to discuss other payment options. Withdrawing from the competition will result in a reserve being called forward, if a reserve is able to attend you will be refunded, if a reserve is unable to be found you will not receive a refund.
6. **Travel Authority.** The use of the Representational Sport Travel Vote is authorised for this fixture in accordance with [2019DIN10-025](#). Applicants are to use their own UIN and Purpose of Travel (POT) Code 16 and also quote their own or the bidders unit UIN on the FMT 1000 when applying for white fleet vehicles. **Players should make every effort to minimise costs by vehicle sharing.**
7. **Clubhouse Dress.** Smart casual wear is acceptable throughout clubhouse, no jeans or collarless shirts are permitted, Corps shirts are expected to be worn if owned. Golf shoes are not to be worn in the clubhouse. Jacket and tie are not required.
8. **Competition Rules.** The matches will be played in line with the Rules of Golf as regulated by the R&A.

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9. **On Duty Status.** Players should advise their CoC to ensure that their participation in this event has been published on respective Unit Part 1 Orders, to formalise their 'on duty' status for this event.

10. Prior to completing your entry into this event, you are to ensure that this AI is brought to the attention of your Commanding Officer or line manager for approval. CO's are to satisfy themselves they are content for the SP to be released. Should your availability for this competition change, please contact the Royal Signals Golf Secretary at the earliest opportunity.

### Captains Responsibilities

11. As the nominated captain of the day, **SSgt Milan Rai** is to ensure that the following are completed:

- a. Captains Match Day responsibilities
- b. Captains Post-match responsibilities

12. **Captains Match Day Responsibilities.** Table 3 contains your match day responsibilities.

Ser	Task	Check
1	Liaise with Golf Club representative to confirm dietary requirements have been met. Dietary requirements will be emailed to the match captain prior to the fixture.	
2	Decide pairings and brief team on the pairings for the day	
3	Introduce yourself to the opposition captain	
4	Confirm format (morning – 4BBB (friendly), afternoon - singles match play (AGA league)).	
5	Exchange team sheet/playing order with the opposition captain	
6	Gather team together, take a team photograph – white R Signals Polo shirts on display where possible (preferably outdoors)	
7	Encourage other photos to be taken (without breaking etiquette)	
8	Encourage players to use social media to provide updates throughout the day, try and keep this to one single thread. You may want to nominate a social media rep for the day to do this.	
9	Collate scores and complete the results sheet, ensure the results sheet is signed by both captains.	
10	Gather information from the pairings for the post-match report	
11	Final briefing – thank you to the opposition, club Staff etc and a quick summary of the match, including the result.
