ARMY GOLF ASSOCIATION (SCOTLAND) SUMMER MEETING KINROSS GC 3 JULY 2024

- 1. After the success of our Spring meeting at Glenbervie GC the Summer meeting will take place at Kinross GC (KY13 8EU) on Wednesday 3 Jul 2024. Play will be over two rounds with both the Bruce and Montgomery courses being played by all competitors. The first tee time on both the Montgomery and the Bruce will be 0820, the 2nd round will commence at 1332 after lunch.
- 2. Format The format will be a stableford competition in 3 handicap divisions, 0 9, 10 18, 19 to 28, all off the yellow tees (red for ladies) using full handicap allowance from the course WHS table with a maximum handicap 28.
- 3. All competitors are entered into the 3 divisions and prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - a. Combined Stableford 1st, 2nd and 3rd each division.
 - b. Nearest the pin and longest drive on both course's morning and afternoon rounds, the holes will be selected on the day.

AGA Members only:

- c. Only paid members of the AGA are eligible to win the coveted title of AGA Scottish Champion.
- d. The format for the overall Army Scottish Champion will be the best combined <u>Gross</u> Stableford which will allow us to identify the Champion Golfer. Play will be off the yellow tees (red for ladies).
- 4. Cost for the day is £60.00 this includes prizes, the green fees, and all catering (breakfast and lunch).
- 5. For those requiring buggies these are available at a cost of £40.00 for the day and should be booked directly with Greig at the Pro shop on 01577 865125, I have provisionally reserved 7 buggies for the day.
- 6. Dress Normal golfing attire on the golf course. If you have an AGA Scotland shirt, then please wear this to advertise the Society in the club house.
- 7. Please complete the attached entry form and return to me by email and pay your entry fee of £60.00 by BACS direct to the AGA account using **SURNAME/KINROSS** as the reference. Account details are:

- 8. The start sheet will be published once all entries have been received. If you require an early or late tee time, or you want to play in a specific group please annotate on your entry application. Please be at the course 1 hour before your tee time for breakfast rolls and coffee and then be at the first tee 10 minutes before your start time.
- 9. No prize giving will take place on the day to prevent the need to hang around on completion of your rounds. The scores will be published on WhatsApp, the Face Book page and on the email distribution list. The prize giving will take place after the curtain closer at St Michaels on 13 Nov 24 which as per previous years will be a Texas scramble with a shot gun start so all competitors finish at the same time and a proper prize giving event can be held.
- 10. Please get your application forms to me as early as you can to ensure your participation. This year to reduce cost there will be no evening meal, anyone wishing to eat after their second round should book with the club on the day before commencing their second round.
- 11. Regulars, reserves, veterans and civilians can apply for AGA membership, AGA membership can be achieved by logging on to the AGA website http://www.armygolf.co.uk where it will cost £15 for a year's membership. By you joining the AGA this increases the annual grant AGA(S) receives from the AGA allowing us to offset events throughout the year.
